 - Ivan Kalas, Slovakian representative proposed to organize Eurologo 2007 Conference at Bratislava using Comenius University facilities, where they have very good conditions, if participants are not more than 250. He intends to broader the scope of the conference trying to attract more people

on the educational field, not necessarily working with Logo, but on the same educational framework.

Considering the main contributions of Slovak group for the Logo community in the last few years, all delegates voted in favour.

Other delegates expressed their wish to run the Conference on the future, namely, delegates from Slovenia, Lithuania and Russia.

2. The usefulness and opportunity of having a Eurologo scientific journal was discussed. It was decided not to run one, but to stimulate Logo researchers to publish in scientific journals that already exist, like the one edited by Valentina Dagiene "Informatics in Education".

On the other hand, it should be useful to have a more teachers' oriented publication for sharing good practices, challenging algorithms and new ideas and experiences. This can be done by on-line publication with very deburatic process of contributing. Jenny Sendova, Brian Harvey, Erich Neuwirth and Secundino Correia volunteered to study the problem and, in some way, bring this idea to life during the next two years.

3. It was decided to clean some names from the ESC board that are no longer active on the field. It will be send an email to all delegates not attending neither participating, so they can confirm their intentions. In the case they are not interested anymore to be included, they can suggest somebody on the country doing valuable research on the field.

Considering that some countries are not represented on the ESC, the Chairmen of the Conference, by suggestion of Gerald Futschek, proposed the following names of people attending the Conference to join the ESC: Birgit Wursthorn (Germany), Dimitris Alimisis (Greece), Michele Moro (Italy), Slavica Grkovska (Macedonia), Nina Gouskova (Russia). The name of Witold Kranas, considered the excellent job done on organizing this Conference, was also proposed. All these new members were accepted and welcomed by the older ones.

Finally, following the tradition, Andzrej Walat was nominated the next ESC Chairman and Ivan Kalas the next Secretary.
